Accomplishments

Cost of Living Index

- Produced quarterly Cost of Living Index publication for the 55th year
- Increased participation in the Cost-of-Living Index from 271 regions in Q1 2023 to 296 areas in Q3 2023
- Successfully integrated web-sourced Datasembly's grocery data and updated approaches to gathering gas prices and mortgage rates to significantly alleviate data collector workload. Local partners need only gather price data on 22 items, down from 61 items
- · 20 new licenses have been initiated to expand dissemination of Cost-of-Living Index data to a broader audience

State Business Incentives

- · Successfully updated the database, which now includes 2,442 incentives programs
- Released a blog series that covered: general and regional program trends, agribusiness programs, and SSBCI 2.0 programs
- Reached out to 400+ program managers to verify incentive program information
- Continued our multi-year partnership with SelectUSA (the U.S. Department of Commerce) to provide content to international companies seeking U.S. facility locations

Policy, Economic Research, and Technical Assistance

- Updated the Certifications and Licenses data with the latest 2018-2022 averages.
- Updated a medium-term employment projections module to the Projections Suite software as a companion to 10-year labor force projections
- Conducted preliminary research on automation exposure in different occupations to inform employment projections
- Teamed with George Washington University to support the National Science Foundation's National Center for Science and Engineering Statistics' (NCSES) use of administrative data to analyze training and education of the nation's skilled technical workforce
- Updated labor force projections to supplement the state employment projections process in support of the Projections Managing Partnership
- Conducted research on the challenges and capacity constraints of states to provide substate and skills projections data with support from the Lumina Foundation
- Provided research and facilitation support to increase labor market data use for key intermediaries serving low-income youth and adults in collaboration with Jobs for the Future and Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation
- Worked with DoD's Manufacturing Technology Education and Workforce Development program to build a network and explore the DoD manufacturing talent pipeline
