Accomplishments

Newsletters - Bi-Weekly Updates, Quarterly

- To date we have distributed 22 Bi-Weekly Updates and 4 C2ER Quarterly issues to more than 5,500 members and targeted partners
- Delivered high-impact weekly marketing emails, leading to significant increase in paid registration for conference and trainings compared to 2023

Annual Conference

- Conducted the Annual Conference June 12–14, with three optional preconference training courses on June 11, 2024, in Norfolk, VA
- Attracted more than 250 paid and sponsored attendees, an increase of 20% compared to 2023 and reflecting continued growth since the pandemic
- Announced 65th annual conference in Sacramento, CA from May 28-30

Training and Certification

- Organized and conducted five instructor-led training courses:

- Alleviated data collector workload by integrating web-sourced grocery data and incorporating alternative methods for gas price and mortgage rate data collection
- Identified new tool for acquiring and integrating utility rates in Q1 2024
- Expanded COLI access through 26 new licensees
- · Published 20+ blog posts about COLI
- Refreshed COLI website to increase engagement and ease of use (ongoing)
- Increased referrals for new bundled database created for colleges and libraries

Economic Research and Technical Assistance

- Updated the C2ER/LMI Institute dataset summarizing the availability of Certifications and Licenses by state with latest 2019-2023 averages
- Conducted preliminary research on automation exposure in different occupations to inform state and regional employment projections
- Explored use of administrative data from NSF National Center for Science and Engineering Statistics to analyze training and education of the nation's skilled technical workforce in collaboration with George Washington University
- Conducted research on the challenges facing states in providing substate and skills projections data with support from the Lumina Foundation
- Provided research and facilitation support to increase labor market data use for selected intermediaries serving low-income youth and adults in collaboration with Jobs for the Future and Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation
- Identified workforce network partners committed to building manufacturing talent pipeline for DoD's Manufacturing Technology Education and Workforce Development program
- Launched the Data User Insights Academy through the LMI Institute and funded by the Employment and Training Administration (ETA). This initiative brings together data producers (state LMI shops) and data users to learn how state LMI data can be more accessible and user friendly

- Continued to update a database with 2,426 incentives state programs
- Continued our multi-year partnership with SelectUSA (the U.S. Department of Commerce) to provide content to international companies seeking U.S. facility locations
