CREC is searching for a Leader with a passion for improving systems and delivering results for communities with high poverty rates, communities in economic transition, and communities of color. The ideal Leader would be able to demonstrate expertise in one or more of the following capabilities:

- knowledge of labor market information producers, users, data quality and access issues with an understanding of how to protect and share confidential data;
- ability to forge partnerships between data users and data producers;
- ability to engage and motivate data system improvements at state

- and local development agencies and organizations;
- ability to conduct research on industrial and occupational change;
- experience using data to evaluate and improve training and job matching programs serving Black and Latinx communities.

This Leader would also have demonstrated ability or strong interest in connecting research professionals and program practitioners to advance discovery, learning, and programmatic objectives. Expected to design research, technical assistance, and learning activities to advance partnerships and to expand our existing network of state and local data providers and data users, including workforce intermediaries and local development organizations.
