Finalists will present at the [2026 UEDA Summit, co-hosted by University of West Florida](#), where the audience will vote for category winners.

Innovation - Advances in research and development across the full research spectrum.

Place - Contributions to the vitality and character of communities and regions.

Impact - Sustaining impact on regional economic diversification and community advancement.

Review Criteria

Nominations for the Awards of Excellence will be based on the following criteria:

- **Ingenuity:** originality and creativity within the project's approaches and results
- **Performance:** relevant milestones, result timelines, progress trackers and ROI, performance outcomes
- **Strategic Engagement:** demonstration of leadership, stakeholder engagement efforts, and partnerships
- **Institutionalization:** replicability, scalability, and sustainability of projects
- **Overall:** holistically review on individual opinions

Institutions wishing to nominate their projects for the 2026 Awards of Excellence are required to submit their project using this form. The deadline for applications is **Friday, August 21 by midnight (local submission time)**. **Finalists will be notified by Friday, September 25, 2026**. Finalist presentations and Awards Ceremony will occur at the UEDA Annual Summit in Pensacola, AL on December 2 - 4, 2026. **All selected finalists must attend the Summit in person.**
